CRITERIA & GUIDELINES for

NCERT Awards for Best Practices in Vocational Education

2011 - 2012

Last Date for Receiving the Nominations 14 Dec. 2012



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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this document "Guidelines and Criteria for NCERT (PSSCIVE) Award For Excellence in Vocational Education" is to facilitate the States/UTs in making nominations for the awardees in four categories as mentioned below. The guidelines will also enable the whole process of selection systematic, transparent and trustworthy.

The details of the eligibility and application procedure for each category of the award are given separately with the document. Only complete entries in the prescribed application form, following the prescribed procedure, will be considered for the award.

ABOUT PSSCIVE

PSS Central Institute of Vocational Education (PSSCIVE) is an apex Research and Development organization in the field of Vocational Education. It is a constituent unit of National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), established by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India, in 1993 at Bhopal. It is also a UNESCO-UNEVOC (International Project on Technical and Vocational Education) Centre in India.

ABOUT THE AWARDS

The institutions, teachers, industries and students who perform well in vocational education and set examples to be followed by others need to be appreciated and recognized. This will boost the morale of dedicated persons and motivate others as partners in the effective implementation of VET.

With this objective in view NCERT gives the awards every year to recognize the services of the persons and organisations who have set exemplary standards in specific areas of their functioning. The details of the awards are as follows:

- (1) **Best Vocational Teacher Award** One for each State/ UT. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 5,000/-, a memento and a certificate.
- (2) **Best Vocational Institution Award** One for each State/UT. The award carries a memento and a certificate.
- (3) Best School-Industry Linkage Award- One for each State/ UT. It is given to the school and to the industry for effective collaboration in providing training to vocational students. The award carries a memento and a certificate.
- (4) Best Student Achiever Award It is given to the six best vocational students from each of the six areas (please see the areas wise details inside of the guideline) from each State/ UT. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 2,000/-, a memento and a certificate. (Note: The award for the second best achiever has been withdrawn from 2008-2009).

CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION OF AWARDEES

In order to assist states in identifying and nominating the best in the above categories, PSSCIVE developed a proforma containing criteria for selecting the awardees. The proforma should be used and the person/institution with the maximum score may be recommended for the award. This will make the whole process of selection, transparent, systematic and objective. The procedures of selection, is given below.

(1) Best Vocational Teacher Award:

1.1 Eligibility

- a) Full-time/ Part-time Vocational Teacher/ Instructor with at least 4 years (2 years for North-East States) of teaching experience at the 10+2 level in successive academic sessions are eligible for the award.
- b) Vocational Teachers/Instructors who have received the, NCERT Award for Best Vocational Teacher in the preceding 03 years (2008-09 to 2010-11) are not eligible for the award.

1.2 Selection Procedure (for Directorates of Education)

- 1. Make copies of the criteria(given below and send it to the potential teachers (Either through the district office or the regional office).
- 2. The Principal, in consultation with the teacher, may fill up the rating and give the total score of the teacher. The Principal should send the nominations in the prescribed format to the Directorate of Education/ Vocational Education/DPI through district/ regional office along with a detailed note on the contribution of the teacher under each criteria given above as justification for recommending a teacher for his/her nomination for the award.
- 3. The Director may appoint a committee at the Directorate level to screen the nominations received from the Principals from different parts of the State. The committee headed by the Director may screen the nominations and select the best teacher at the state level.
- 4. After the selection, the Director will, in the prescribed format, send the nomination to PSSCIVE on or before the last date. It will be appreciated if a detailed note on the specific contributions of the nominated vocational teacher is sent. The Director may take extra care to ensure that the right person is selected to receive the prestigious award and the nominations are sent to PSSCIVE well in time.

(2) Best Vocational Institution Award

2.1 Eligibility Criteria

- a) Institutions, with at least 4 years (2 years for North-East States) of experience in offering vocational courses at the 10+2 level and fulfill the desired criteria, are eligible for the award.
- b) Vocational Institutions which have received the Best Vocational Institution NCERT Awards in the preceding 3 years (2008-09 to 2010-11) are not eligible for the award.

2.2 Selection Procedure

- 1. Make copies of the-criteria (given on the next page) and send it to the promising vocational institutions (Either through the district office or the regional office).
- 2. The Principal will fill up the rating and give the total score of the institution. The Principal should recommend for the nomination of his/her institution in the prescribed format to the Director of Education along with a detailed note on the activities of the institution under each criteria given above as justification for recommending the institution for receiving the award.
- 3. The Director will appoint a committee at the Directorate level to screen the nomination thus received. The committee headed by the Director will screen the nominations and select the best institution.
- 4. After the selection, the Director will send the final nomination, along with his/ her recommendations, to PSSCIVE on or before the last date. It will also be appreciated if a detailed note on the specific contributions of the nominated vocational institution is sent. The Director may take extra care to ensure that the right institution is selected to receive the prestigious award and the nominations are sent to PSSCIVE well in time.

(3) Best School Industry Linkage Award (Institution/ Industry)

3.1 Eligibility

The School and the Industry, which have developed linkages in vocational education at the 10+2 level for facilitating and supporting vocational students are eligible for the award. They should have maintained sustained linkages for at least 4 successive years (2 years for North-East States) and should also fulfill the desired criteria for the award. Vocational Institutions and Industries which have received the NCERT Award for the Best School-Industry Linkage Award in the preceding 3 years (2008-09 to 2010-11) are not eligible for the Award.

3.2 Criteria

- 1. The Institute has signed an MOU with an industry for practical training.
- 2. The students of the institute go to the industry at least once in a week to acquire hands on experience.
- 3. The Industry pays, in kind or cash, some stipend/incentives to the students who undergo practical training in the industry.
- 4. The Industry employs few or all students from among the trainees.
- 5. The Institute has placed a majority of the students under apprenticeship scheme.

3.3 Selection Procedure

- 1. Make copies of the above criteria and send it to the institutions (Either through the district office or the regional office) which have established good linkage with nearby industries for providing practical training to the vocational students.
- 2. The Principal should send the nominations, along with details, to the Director of Education recommending his/her institution and 'the collaborating industries for consideration of the Director.
- 3. The Director will appoint a committee at the Directorate level to screen the nominations thus received. The committee headed by the Director will screen the nominations of the institutions as well as the industry and select the best institution and the industry to receive the award.
- 4. After the selection, the Director will send the final nomination of the institution and the industry along with his/her own recommendations to PSSCIVE on or before the last date. The Director should also send a detailed note on the specific contribution of the institution and the industry in providing practical training to vocational students. The Director will take extra care to ensure that the right institution and the industry are selected to receive the prestigious award and the nominations are sent to PSSCIVE well in time.

(4) Best Student Achiever Award

4.1 Eligibility

The candidate must have secured the highest percentage of marks in the final examination of XIIth class in the academic year 2011-12 in the vocational stream. Nominations must be sent separately, in each of the six areas, as mentioned below:

Area of Vocational Education

- 1. Engineering and Technology (for example: Automobile, Electronics, Leather goods, Chemical and Pharmaceuticals, Gems and Jewellery, Building construction, IT, ITES, BPO etc.)
- 2. Agriculture (for example: Horticulture, Floriculture, Crop Production, Seed Technology, Food Processing, etc.)
- 3. Business and Commerce (for example: Retail, Banking, Insurance, Transport, Warehouse and packaging).
- 4. Home Science (for example: Textile and Garments, Handlum and handicrafts, Tourism, Hospitality and travel, etc.)
- 5. Health and Paramedical (for example: Health Care, Nursing, etc.)
- 6. Humanities Science and Education (for example: Media, Entertainment, Education skills development other unorganized sectors.)

4.2 Criteria

The vocational student who achieved the highest marks at +2 Board Examination in academic year 2010-11 in any vocational course.

4.3 Selection Procedure

The name and address of the student (area wise) who achieved the highest marks among vocational students in the state will be obtained from the Board concerned and forwarded to PSSCIVE.
