Sub:- Intermediate Education - Government Junior Colleges in the State - Hiring of retired Persons in existing vacancies of Junior Lecturers in Govt. Junior Colleges - Certain Instructions - Issued

The Regional Joint Directors of Intermediate Education / District Vocational Education Officers / Principals of Government Junior Colleges in the State are informed that there are many vacancies of Junior Lecturers existing as on today and quite a considerable number of vacancies arise every month in Govt. Junior Colleges for the following reasons:

- (1) There are many lady employees who go on maternity leave in the middle of the academic year.
- (2) Retirements
- (3) Due to sudden deaths
- (4) Due to lecturers going on long leave on medical grounds
- (5) Due to promotions of Junior Lecturers to Govt. Degree Colleges and as Principals of Govt. Junior Colleges

Even to engage Contract Faculty in such temporary vacancies is very difficult as a fresh notification has to be issued, obtained applications and arrange them in order of merit cum roster and conduct counselling through a Zonal Committee. This is a long and lengthy process.

The Government in G.O.Rt.No.284, Higher Education (IE) Department, dated 03.7.2014 have accorded permission for renewal of Contract faculty working in Government Junior Colleges in Andhra Pradesh State from 04.06.2014 for the academic year 2014-15. But, no orders were issued for engagement of fresh Contract Faculty for the current academic year. Thus, many vacancies remain unfilled on date.

Hence, the RJDIEs/ DVEOs/ Principals of Govt. Junior Colleges in the State are directed to hire the retired persons i.e., retired and qualified School Assistants with P.G. and High School experience only, Retired Junior Lecturers, Retired Lecturers of Degree Colleges, Retired Professors of Universities who have rich teaching experience in the available vacancies on payment of remuneration on hourly basis of Rs.150/- per hour not exceeding Rs.10,000/- per month and submit proposals to this Office for claiming their payment from the budget provided by the Government under the "300-Contractual Head of Account".
